

Installing EASERA 1.1.3 in Windows 7

Introduction

EASERA 1.1.3 was written before Windows 7 was created and lacks some licensing components that Windows 7 needs. Fortunately there is a work-around for this problem until AFMG completes an update to EASERA.

SysTune uses newer licensing components that are compatible with Windows 7 and can be used to successfully install and license EASERA.

Installation Procedure

Step 1

If you have already installed EASERA on your computer and are having licensing problems, the first step is to uninstall EASERA and EaseraGuard.

Step 2

The second step is to install SysTune.

If you do not own SysTune, you can download it by registering for the 30 day free trial at:

You only need to download and install the SysTune program. You do not need to license it. Once SysTune is installed, you may install EASERA

Step 3

Install EASERA 1.1.3 and EaseraGuard

Step 4

IMPORTANT: You must complete this step to ensure the proper Windows 7 path structure before you attempt to download your EASERA license key.

RIGHT-CLICK on the EASERA Program icon and select "Run As Administrator". Let the program start and completely open the Licensing Registration window – then close all windows. Do not attempt to register yet!

Step 5

Start EASERA in the normal fashion, let it open all the way to the Licensing Registration window and download your license. It should now install without any problems.
